- 1. Battle Born PTA is accepting applications for its 2018 Scholarship Program. Scholarships have a minimum award value of five hundred (\$500) and may be worth more depending on the number of applicants.
- 2. Applications are open to full time college students or incoming freshman that graduated from a Nevada High School and are permanent residents of Nevada.
- 3. Applicants must be a member of their local high school PTA or PTSA or they can join Battle Born PTA if there is not a PTA or PTSA at their school. Membership information for Battle Born PTA is included below. Membership will be verified with the respective PTA unit.
- 4. Eligible applicants must attend a college or university or vo-tech center. There is no restriction on field of study.
- 5. Any applicant who has received more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) in other combined scholarships or grants in an academic year is not eligible to apply.
- 6. All information requested must be provided. Applications must be <u>received via email</u> by April1,2018. Winners will be notified by May 1, 2018.
- 7. If necessary, Battle Born reserves the right to require references and or personal interviews to determine winners.
